

INTERVENTION ACADEMY ON-LINE COMPUTER SERVICES – APPROPRIATE USE AGREEMENT

Students are responsible for knowing and following the rules and regulations governing student use of technology resources as follows:

1. Students are expected to limit the use of technology resources for appropriate and permissible educational purposes only. The student will exercise good judgment and discretion at all times.
2. Use of technology resources in violation of federal, state or, local laws or regulations, including but not limited to copying material protected by copyright laws, violating criminal laws, or transmitting any material that is threatening or obscene, is prohibited. Students are responsible for knowing and following all federal, state, and local laws regulating the information available on the Internet and other on-line services.
3. Use of technology resources for private, personal, or commercial business activities, including but not limited to advertising, promotion, purchasing, and/or political lobbying, is prohibited.
4. Use of technology resources in a manner that is inappropriate or offensive to others is prohibited. The Administration has the authority and reserves the right to make the final decision regarding what is offensive or inappropriate. Examples of inappropriate and offensive use of technology resources are:
 - Sending, receiving, displaying, or reproducing terms, messages or pictures that could violate the nondiscrimination policy or other policies.
 - Sending, receiving, displaying or reproducing terms, messages or pictures which could be considered offensive, threatening, obscene or pornographic by a reasonable person or which are otherwise determined to be inappropriate by the Administration.
 - Harassing, insulting, stalking, attacking, or invading the privacy of others.
 - Any use which could reasonably result in damage to IA technology resources.
 - Using another person's access code, changing your username or password, or giving your code to another person.
 - Unauthorized invasion or use of another person's folders, files, or work.
 - Intentionally wasting resources.
 - Divulging personal information about yourself or others to strangers (including address, telephone and credit card numbers, access code or other personal or confidential information).
5. The Administration may deny, revoke, or suspend a student's access to technology resources if the student violates this policy. All decisions are final and not subject to review or appeal.
6. Students have no property, liberty, or other interest or expectation of privacy in the use of technology resources. The Administration reserves the right to monitor and review any material accessed, displayed, stored, transmitted or reproduced through the use of technology resources. The Administration, at its discretion, may edit or remove any material placed or stored within technology resources that violates this policy.
7. All students and parents must sign the Technology Resources User Agreement and Permission form, which will be kept on file in Student Services.

Violation of the Use of Technology Resources Policy is a violation of the Code of Conduct. Students who violate the policy are subject to disciplinary action, which may include up to a 10-day suspension or termination of enrollment. Violations of a criminal nature may be reported to the local law enforcement agency for prosecution. Intervention Academy prohibits and assumes no responsibility for the unlawful actions of any student using technology resources.

As parent/legal guardian I grant permission for my child to use IA's technology resources, which includes the Internet and other on-line services. I have read the Technology Resource Use Policy. I understand and agree that my student must abide by the law and the rules and regulations stated in the policy, failure to do so may result in disciplinary action, loss of technology resource privileges and/or criminal or civil legal sanctions for my child. I understand that my child will have the ability to access information from outside the educational community, some of which may be illegal and inappropriate. Therefore, I agree to accept responsibility for guiding my student and convey to him/her appropriate standards in the use of technology resources. I further understand and agree that Intervention Academy is not responsible for any violations or misuse of technology resources, which may occur as the result of my student's actions.
